


# TV PROGRAMMES



## Across

5. The short period of advertisements between television programmes (MAINLY UK): *I'll make us a cup of coffee in the next break.*
6. A short length of time in a show which is given to a particular performer: *The comedian is doing a daily five-minute \_\_\_\_\_ on M<sup>a</sup> Teresa Campos show.*
7. A game or competition in which you answer questions.
8. Political news about events happening now.
10. A \_\_\_\_\_ show (UK, also *talk show* US) is an informal television or radio programme on which famous people are asked questions about themselves and their work.
12. An advertisement which is broadcast on television or radio.
13. A set of television or radio broadcasts on the same subject or using the same characters but in different situations: *I missed the second episode of the \_\_\_\_\_ so I don't know what's going on now.*
14. An amusing television or radio show in which the same characters appear in each programme in a different story. (INFORMAL)
15. A series of television or radio programmes about the lives and problems of a particular group of characters. The series continues over a long period and is broadcast (several times) every week. (INFORMAL)

## Down

1. The weather \_\_\_\_\_ is a statement of what the weather is likely to be for the next day or few days, usually broadcast on television or radio or printed in a newspaper.
2. A television programme whose story is based on an event or situation that really happened although it is not intended to be accurate in every detail.
3. A news \_\_\_\_\_ is a short programme on television or radio often about something that has just happened.
4. A film or television or radio programme that gives facts and information about a subject: a biography, wildlife, history, etc.
9. An entertaining programme about the lives of real people, especially people who live in the same place or do the same job.
10. Films made using characters and images which are drawn rather than real, and which is usually amusing.
11. A story on television or radio or in a newspaper, etc. which is broadcast or printed in separate parts: *Her last novel has been made into a television \_\_\_\_\_.*
