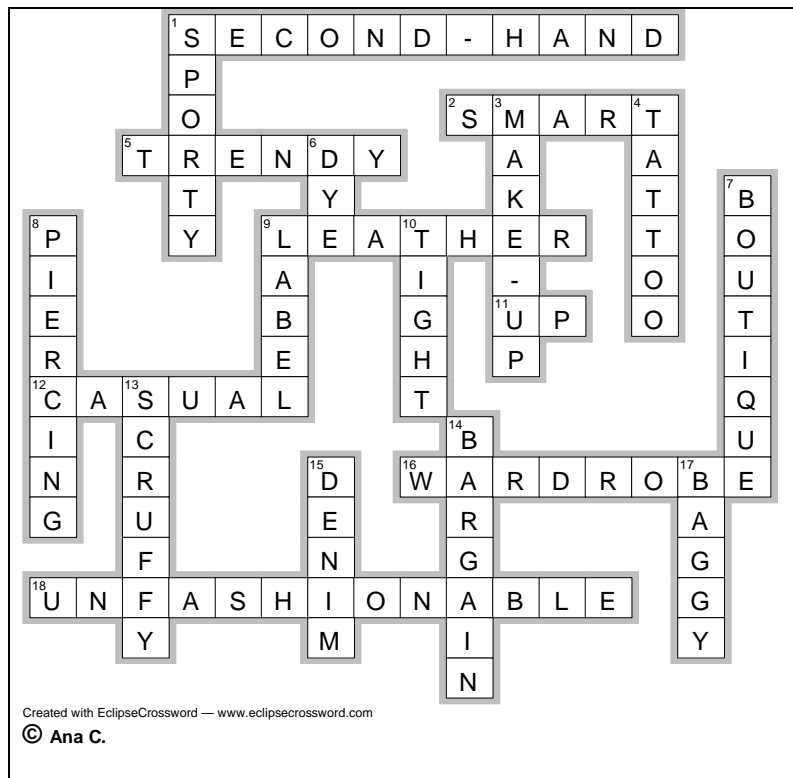

9. **LEATHER**—Animal skin treated in order to preserve it, and used to make shoes, bags, clothes, equipment, etc: a _____ coat/belt/handbag, etc.

12. **CASUAL**—(of clothes) Not formal or not suitable for special occasions.
16. **WARDROBE**—All of the clothes that a person owns: 'I sometimes feel that my winter _____ is rather lacking; I don't have many winter clothes.'

1. **SPORTY**—_____ clothes are informal and often look like the ones that you could wear for sports.
3. **MAKE-UP**—(hyphenated word) Coloured substances used on your face to improve or change your appearance.
4. **TATTOO**—A permanent image, pattern or word on the skin which is created by using needles to put colours under the skin.
6. **DYE**—To change the colour of something (e.g. your hair or a clothes item) using a special liquid.
7. **BOUTIQUE**—A small shop that sells fashionable clothes, shoes, jewellery, etc.
8. **PIERCING**—A hole made in the body for wearing jewellery, or the process of making such a hole.
9. **LABEL**—Her favourite designer _____ (= maker of expensive clothes) is Armani.
10. **TIGHT**—Clothes or shoes that are _____ fit the body too closely and are uncomfortable.
13. **SCRUFFY**—Untidy and dirty.
14. **BARGAIN**—Something on sale at a lower price than its true value.
15. **DENIM**—A thick strong cotton cloth, usually blue in colour, used especially for making jeans: a _____ jacket and jeans.
17. **BAGGY**—(of clothes) Hanging loosely because of being too big or having been stretched.
