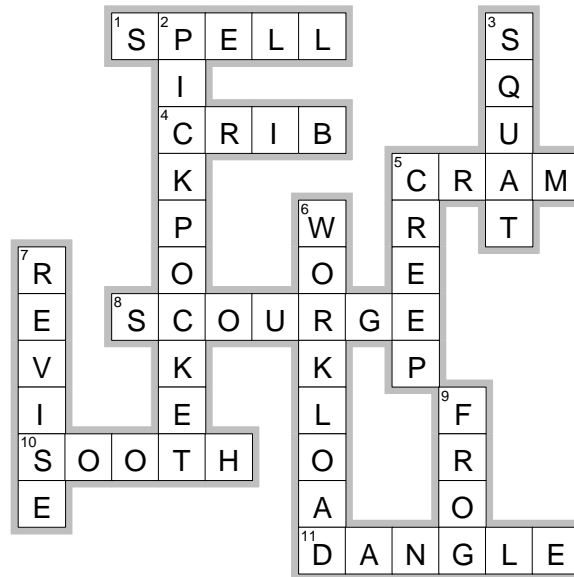


# GENERAL VOCABULARY Key

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### ACROSS

1. **SPELL**—spell (MAGIC); spoken words which are thought to have magical power, or (the condition of being under) the influence or control of such words
4. **CRIB**—to copy someone else's work, especially dishonestly
5. **CRAM**—to try to learn a lot very quickly before an exam
8. **SCOURGE**—something or someone that causes great suffering or a lot of trouble
10. **SOOTH**—to make someone feel calm or less worried
11. **DANGLE**—to hang loosely, or to hold something so that it hangs loosely

### DOWN

2. **PICKPOCKET**—a thief who steals things out of pockets or bags, especially in a crowd
3. **SQUAT**—to live in an empty building or area of land without the permission of the owner
5. **CREEP**—someone who tries to make someone more important like them by being very polite and helpful in a way that is not sincere
6. **WORKLOAD**—the amount of work to be done, especially by a particular person or machine in a period of time
7. **REVISE**—to study again something you have already learned, in preparation for an exam
9. **FROG**—a French person
