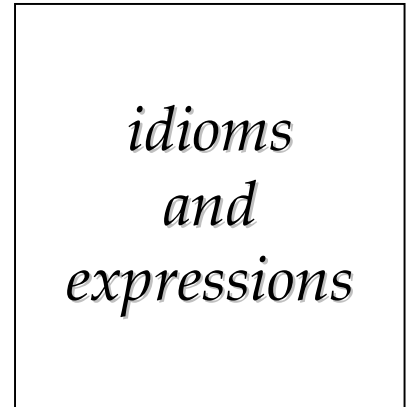


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3. **LAUGH**—To be succesful or proved right in the end, after people have criticised or defeated you earlier: to have the last
