UNIT 1	Del 1 al 14 de marzo	<p><i>Email a friend you have not met for some years. Write about what your life was like when you were teenagers and the things you used to do together. How has your life changed?</i></p> <p>You can use the ideas in the activities and examples on page 12, and also the Suggested answer to Activity 9 (p.17) in the Answer Key on pp.116-117.</p> <p><i>Write about your life ten years ago and your life now.</i></p> <p>Use the simple past and the structures <i>used to /didn't use to</i> when you write about habits in the past. Use the simple present to describe your present life or habits.</p>
UNIT 2	Del 8 al 21 de marzo	<p><i>Write an advertisement for 'That's English!' (p.27, activity 7).</i></p> <p>Organise your ideas following the suggestions in the activity. The Suggested answers in the Answer Key on p.120 can help you.</p>
UNIT 3	Del 15 al 28 de marzo	<p><i>Tell a happy anecdote that happened to you this month or recently. What happened? When? Where? (p.37, activity 8).</i></p> <p>See the Suggested answer on p.123 for ideas.</p>
UNIT 4	Del 22 de marzo al 4 de abril	<p><i>Write about a musician/band that you like. (p.42, activity 14).</i></p> <p>The text in activity 13 on the same page and the extracts from famous musicians' biographies on p.40 can help you.</p>
UNIT 5	Del 29 de marzo al 11 de abril	<p><i>Write about Christmas and New Year's Eve and how people celebrate them in your country and in your family.</i></p> <p>The ideas and vocabulary in the unit may be helpful, and also the Suggested answer to activity 8 (p.57) in the Answer Key on p.130.</p>
UNIT 6	Del 5 al 18 de abril	<p><i>Write about a weird dream you had. Describe the dream and give a possible interpretation of its meaning.</i></p> <p>Use the texts on p.60 for ideas and the Suggested answers to activity 9 (p.67) in the Answer Key, on p.134.</p>

UNIT 7	Del 12 al 25 de abril	<p><i>An email of advice. Write to Susie and give her advice on what she can do about the environmental problems in her street (p.77, activity 10).</i></p> <p>The ideas in the Suggested answer in the Answer Key on p. 137 may guide you.</p>
UNIT 8	Del 19 de abril al 2 de mayo	<p><i>A blog post: A technological device that has changed your life (p.87, activity 5).</i></p> <p>Read the texts in activity 4 on the same page for ideas, and also the Suggested answer to activity 5 in the Answer Key, p.140.</p>
UNIT 9	Del 26 de abril al 9 de mayo	<p><i>Write about your favourite film/TV comedy or drama show.</i></p> <p>Use the ideas on page 90 and the text in activity 4, p.91 as a model. The texts in activity 6, p.97 and the Suggested answers to activity 7 (same page) in the Answer Key, p.144 will also help you.</p>
UNIT 10	Del 3 al 16 de mayo	<p><i>An amazing piece of news: 'Planet visited by Chinese astronauts' / 'Woman elected President' (p.107, activity 8).</i></p> <p>Choose one of the headlines and write your own newspaper article about it. What happened? When? Where? What was people's reaction?</p> <p>Read the Suggested answers in the Answer Key on page 148. The rest of texts and exercises in unit 10 can also help you familiarise with the language of news. Remember to include passive structures in your article.</p>
